Welcome and Introductions - All

All members introduced themselves to the group. AG welcomed everyone to the second meeting. Apologies were given as above.

ES gave an update on the purpose of the working group.

By 2025, we can ensure that every child with diabetes has equal access to the same level of diabetes care and education, that allows effective self-management through the delivery of a national standard programme supported by diabetes teams that include psychologists and social workers.

The core members have broken the aim into 6 subgroups.

This subgroup will look at transition and how variation and development of an interface between paediatric and adult diabetes care nationally, so the care can transition seamlessly

NHSE/I National Framework for Transition: Ensuring a high quality of care for young people as they move into adult services – Update - Katie Puplett (Senior Policy Manager, CYP's Transformation Programme, NHSE/I)

Core capability framework for transition now complete awaiting sign off from comms team National framework for transition also complete. Both will go through approvals process together once signed off.

Discussion ongoing on how to launch these documents. strategic implementation group Work with CQC. Framework sent to them in current state who will develop a brief guide for adult services based on these.

New team called the Community Currency team who will be setting up a community currency for






transition, which means that primary care and adult services will get paid for doing transition well and doing transition properly. This is hoped to be up and running 2023/24.

Pilots around transition in diabetes care 1 per region to take place. Looking to creating evidence-based material on what makes a good transition process.

Transition and Young Adult Care Pilot: Principles NHS



AG asked what the difference with the framework of 2016 to 2022. The difference now is we have an opportunity to prioritize transition in a way that we haven't done before, so we have, obviously the CYP regional Leads. We have a reporting structure and looking to build incentives into this.

VV asked how the pilots' units will be chosen. FM stated they will be looking at units with differing traits. Units will bid to take part in the pilots. Information will be released on this.

Burdett National Transition Nursing Network Update - Louise Porter (National Lead Nurse, Burdett National Transition Nursing Network)

Work across England to roll out a quality improvement process for in transition that was developed in Leeds. Looking to develop a national training package with KP. Scoping exercise with GP's and the Royal college of GP's looking at how a pathway for transition can be developed for GP's. Early discussions about having an annual review for young people in transition.

The Seamless Transition Project –Kasia Muszynska, Programme Manager, The Seamless Transition Project

KM gave an outline of the project. <u>View presentation</u> Key points:

- Funded by the North West Coast Clinical Network (NHSE)
- Four training modules created
- Key speakers identified and recorded during covid-19 pandemic
- Phase 1 of the 4 modules piloted at 3 sites: Liverpool, Preston and Alder Hey and all provided feedback.
- Lots of training required
