Access to testing/review

May be an issue about access to pick up in primary care education package. Contacting a GP practice for review varies between practices – some have all referrals as e-consult forms which are then triaged by GP that day.

Prompt recognition/referral by primary care

Discussion focussed on GP practices but important to be considering ED departments too. Access to capillary blood glucose testing should be there in each surgery but there is some variation. Appear to be knowledge gaps in some GP trainees -? need to ensure on GP training programmes. Use of CBG machine should be core competence for all medical students.

Yeovil and Wales representatives discussed success through education programmes to primary care. Face to face mandatory sessions happen in some places but not all. Developing educational resources would be useful work. You tube videos were accessed well in one project by those who didn't attend session directly. Roll out of training needs to be local with networks liaising with local service leads – supported by training materials.

Screening

No recent update on potential plans for a national screening programme. An anecdote of a young person who hanged themselves after being found to be antibody positive through a sibling study was shared.

First Year of Care Subgroup

LS gave an update on the PDPEAS working group in the North West network, please see presentation <u>here</u>. LS shared with the group that it would be good to consider language around foods within the newly diagnosed pathway.

ES recapped from the last meeting in October 2021, and then group continued their discussion around the common themes for the first year of care and decided that moving forwards there will be an inpatient stay and non-inpatient stay pathway in order to cater for all diabetes units. As there is variation around the country of the duration of inpatient stay.

The group discussed how they can ensure that psychology is included in the pathway and it was decided that within the first week there should be some form of contact from the team's psychologist, examples include face to face meet and greet, phone call or leaflet can be classed as a contact. This can ensure that the patient is aware of the team psychologist from the start of their diagnosis.

Other changes and discussion points include:

- The group wants to ensure that there is an expectation of home downloading on the pathway.
- Change 'prior to discharge' to 'within the first week' of diagnosis
- Discussing time in range at the first OPA
- Technology should be age dependent but if diagnosed under 5 years old then pump/CGM should be considered within the first month of diagnosis
- An addition of 'introduction to advance technology' should be used to ensure all patients know that other treatment regimens are available to them
