<p>Welcome and Introductions - All</p> <p>All members introduced themselves to the group.</p> <p>The Aim of the Subgroup - Drs Alok Gupta, Martha Ford-Adams & Sanjay Gupta</p> <p><i>By 2025, we can ensure that every child with diabetes has equal access to the same level of diabetes care and education, that allows effective self-management through the delivery of a national standard programme supported by diabetes teams that include psychologists and social workers.</i></p> <p>The core members have broken the aim into 6 subgroups. This subgroup will look at transition and how variation and development of an interface between paediatric and adult diabetes care nationally, so the care can transition seamlessly.</p> <p>The Seamless Transition Project - Dr Fiona Campbell (National Clinical Lead, CYP Diabetes Network)</p> <p>Key points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Funded by the North West Coast Clinical Network (NHSE) • Built by HMA and powered by Digibete • Four training modules created • Key speakers identified and recorded during covid-19 pandemic • Phase 1 of the 4 modules piloted at 3 sites: Liverpool, Preston and Alder Hey and all provided feedback. • Lots of training required • Phase 2 started and is currently being built. This will be a modification based on feedback from the 1st phase. These modules will be recorded in person rather than virtually as in phase 1. This results in a much higher quality module. • Looking to extend the roll out to 7 or more teams willing to take on the project by the end of 2021. • Plans for guided/supported learning this time round. This will consist of e-Learning, then virtual get together followed by coaching from mentors. • Transition framework and competency standards developed. • Interest from Royal College of Physicians, RCPCH, CQC in supporting the work on transition. <p>RZ – Need to look past vast training required and focus on benefits for seamless transition in diabetes care.</p> <p>FM – Training material challenging in difficult times during pandemic. Very good user interface made this easier. Potential difficulties in engaging with adult colleagues.</p> <p>LP – Stressed importance of using coach available and going forward buddying up.</p>

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Burdett National Transition Nursing Network - Louise Porter (National Lead Nurse, Burdett National Transition Nursing Network)

LP introduced her team and gave a detailed presentation (attached) on how Leeds have used funding from the Burdett Trust to aim to improve the experience of young people age 11 to 25 years with a Long-Term Condition whilst also improving the experience of their families / carers, during the process of moving from children's services to being cared for and settled in adult services.
