



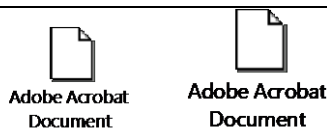

SS gave an update on the launch of the interactive care plan and gave a live demo:

- 19-minute training film and training walk through guide available on clinic portal.
- Trust logo can be added to care plan
- 2 factor authentications for adding a participant for security
- Only one person can be editing the plan at a given time

Group discussion regarding the NHS number being a mandatory field and font size being too small.

OSL raised - Is there a way for parents and schools to access the plan outside of registering for the app. I am aware some parents may have more limited access to tech/be overwhelmed with number of logins. SS – patient needs to be registered for the app for a care plan to be created. Varying use regionally with DigiBete app potentially make using the care plan difficult where not standard practice.

Due to CA apologies, CA gave an update over email - In terms of updates, the main schools project we were working on has been stalled a little due to long-term staff sickness but it should be picking up again soon.

We fed back into the SEND Review green paper consultation and are waiting for the final paper to be published (this might take longer than anticipated as the minister with responsibility for

this area in the Department of Education has changed).
The Health Conditions in Schools Alliance website is having a revamp in the next couple of months. It would be great to hear how we might be able to help paediatric teams with resources for schools etc.

SC and KD raised carb counting training for school staff and how this links to the school care plan and whether there could be a tick box on the care plan where school can highlight whether the school need updated carb counting training. This varies around the country in terms of who's responsibility the carb counting is within the school setting. KD - school point of view, it is important that we have clarity on what training is available locally for us, what information we should expect to receive and from whom (parents / caterers / health team etc), whose responsibility carb counting is. I'd expect that information to be in the child's care plan so that it's clear for all involved.
