	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The data analysis platform has now been split between the results from diabetes teams and eating disorder teams. 26 responses from eating disorder teams.</li> <li>• Topics to include in a national education training includes: feedback from T1DE NHSE pilot sites, communication around weight and body image, technology and T1DE, workshops and involvement from diabetes charities such as JDRF and Diabetes UK.</li> <li>• Idea to hold a Hybrid model national event including diabetes teams from paediatrics and adults as well as eating disorder healthcare professionals.</li> <li>• A cost implication to healthcare professionals was discussed if optimal funding wasn't available</li> <li>• Agree to hold the event in April/May 2025 in the Midlands area</li> <li>• Discussion around logistics of holding a hybrid event with multiple workshops – this will be further discussed once SA has been in touch with Warwick University regarding their event package.</li> </ul>
