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## CYA Type 2 HCP training in managing type 2 diabetes for children

- The Type 2 HCP training has been developed by elearning for health, with input and content from expert clinical editorial group
- Aims to increase healthcare professionals' awareness of how best to care for CYP with type 2 diabetes and help them to keep up to date with the latest treatments and guidance. HCPs to access the training at time convenient to them.
- Primary audience: Those working in specialist children and young adult diabetes services and include doctors/ consultants/ nurses/ dietitians/ psychology staff/ youth workers.
- Secondary audiences: Staff prescribing diabetes medication and staff working in local GP practices that may see CYP with type 2 diabetes.
- Early feedback from participants is extremely positive.

### **Positive user feedback;**

- 84% of respondents thought the programme was good or very good
- 84% of respondents gave a score of 8 or higher out of 10 when asked whether they would recommend this learning resource.
- 89% of respondents agreed/strongly agreed that the programme was easy to understand.
- 69% of respondents agreed/strongly agreed that the programme allowed them to apply their knowledge.

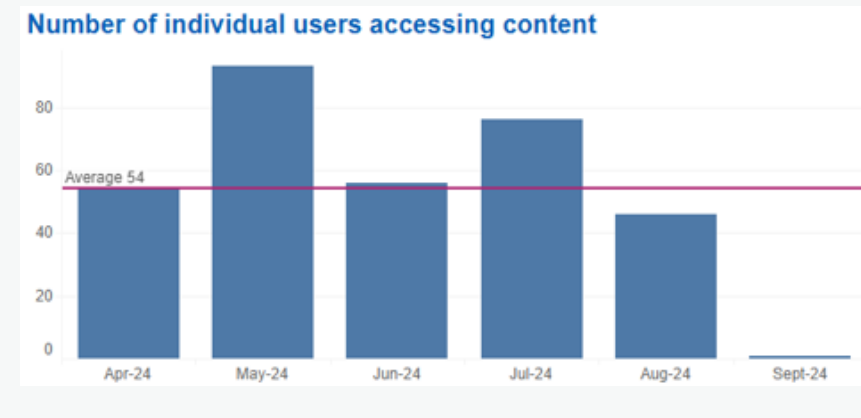
# CYA T2 HCP Training – early data on uptake

There have been over 328 unique user profiles developed, of these, 183 are recorded and we have data for where they are based

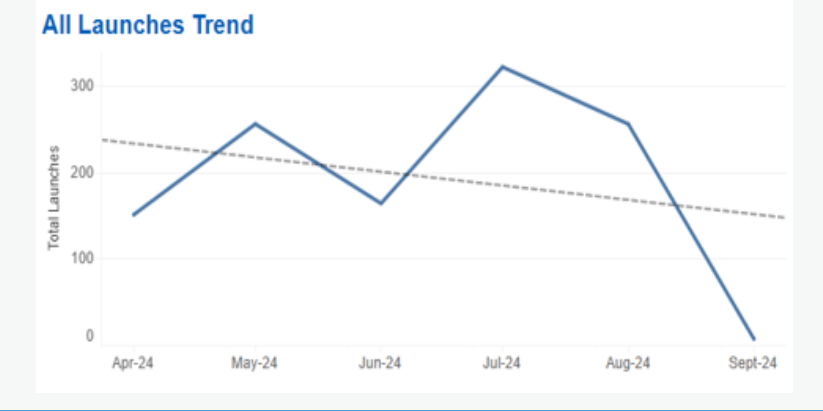
